

Àireamhachd agus Matamataig | Numeracy and Mathematics

•**Number**- sharing objects into equal groups, recognising simple part of a whole (half and quarter). Consolidating number bonds within 20 (addition and subtraction), Learning to correctly form numbers.

Information handling - collecting information using ticks, tally marks, sorting information, creating pictograms and block graph, asking questions to get the information I need. Using simple ICT data handling programmes

Money - Awareness of how money is used, using coins in play, recognise value of all coins, add and subtract within 10p, use 1p,2p, 5p coins to add up to the value of 10p

Litearrachd | Literacy

Listening & Talking: Discussing and comparing characters and events in stories, building confidence in using Gaelic in daily interactions and re-telling stories together

Writing - learning to write simple words and beginning to write Clas 1 common words (Facail Chumanta). Becoming aware of writing on the line, capital letter, full stop and finger spaces in my writing.

Reading - using my knowledge of sounds to help me decode simple words and recognise common words. Sharing Gaelic reading books with my family (Storyworlds) and discussing characters and settings

Phonics - identifying and naming Gaelic sounds & learning associated actions (diagraphs)
